



ANNOUNCING...

At the April 22nd, 2021 DMI Board Meeting, the Directors approved a \$1,500 stipend for two (2) Technical College Risk Manager representatives to attend in person, URMIA's 52nd Annual Conference 2021 being held in Seattle, WA.



Each attendee will be responsible to make and pay for any/all transportation arrangements, hotel reservations, and the Annual Conference registration fees. DMI will reimburse the College post conference. The attendee is expected to attend and participate during the entire URMIA Conference.

Technical College Risk Managers wishing to apply for the in person attendance stipend must be full-time college staff, employed at least two years, and have approval of their immediate supervisor. In addition, their job must be directly related to the College's risk management strategy.

Additionally...

For Technical College Risk Managers and stakeholders wishing to attend but who are restricted from travel, the DMI Board of Directors approved two (2) \$769 stipend awards for the registration fee to virtually attend the Annual Conference per the URMIA guidelines for virtual attendance. The virtual registration option will provide individuals access to several live conference sessions online and recordings of those sessions after the conference ends.

Technical College Risk Managers (and the additional staff attendees) wishing to apply for the virtual meeting attendance registration stipend must be full-time college staff, employed at least two years, and have the approval of their immediate supervisor. In addition, their job(s) must be directly related to the College's risk management strategy.

URMIA conferences contain high quality presentations covering many aspects of higher education risk management. URMIA conferences also provide a fantastic opportunity to network with world-wide higher education risk management professionals.

The 2021 URMIA Annual Conference Stipend Application is included with this announcement and may also be found on the DMI website. Completed applications are due no later than June 25, 2021.

Preferential treatment for in person participation will be given to first time attendees. Selected candidates will be notified in writing and announced at the July 22nd, 2021 Risk Manager's meeting.
