WCTC received funding from DMI's Risk Management Project Award grant for a WTCS system-wide project to offer Youth Protection Training and support to the colleges. Feel free to share invitations with others and select whom to send for the in-person workshop.

In-Person Workshop at WCTC in Pewaukee, WI (March 13-14, 2025)

WCTC is contracting with Praesidium to offer a 2-day in-person workshop held at WCTC's campus in Pewaukee, WI. Each WTCS college may send 3 employees of their choice to attend. **Registration for the workshop, materials, refreshments, and lunch both days of the training are sponsored by the DMI RMPA grant. Colleges are responsible for travel expenses.** Training may cover topics such as: developing a protection of minors policy, screening/training employees, mandated reporters, peer-to-peer abuse, administration/oversight of youth protection programs, performing investigations, and best practices.

Webinars

Praesidium will host 6 live webinars for WTCS colleges with unlimited registrations/college between now and June 30, 2025. Topics may include: identifying offenders and how they operate, preventing false allegations, preventing and responding to peer to peer sexual misconduct, identifying and responding to policy violations and red flag behaviors, responding to abuse, mandated reporting, electronic communications and social media safety, and responding to scenarios and case examples.

Consulting

Each WTCS college will have access to 2 hours of consulting from Praesidium. Praesidium's team of experts can provide custom-tailored consultations and recommendations for abuse prevention. Consultants are available to review and make recommendations on youth protection policies and procedures, screening/selection practices, training curricula, incident reviews and analysis, root cause analyses of incidents, and board guidance.

Who should attend?

College staff and faculty who work with minors and youth programming on campus.
